Clause 1 – Agreement to Sell and Purchase

The Seller agrees to sell and the Buyer agrees to purchase the Vehicle described above on the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement. The sale is subject to the representations, warranties, and covenants contained herein.

Clause 2 – Vehicle Condition; AS IS

The Vehicle is sold AS IS, WHERE IS, with all faults and without any warranties, express or implied, including but not limited to implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. The Buyer acknowledges having had the opportunity to inspect the Vehicle and accepts its condition.

Clause 3 – Title and Ownership

The Seller represents that they are the lawful owner of the Vehicle, free from any liens, charges, or encumbrances. The Seller agrees to transfer clear title to the Buyer upon completion of the sale.

Clause 4 – Delivery

Delivery of the Vehicle shall occur at the location agreed by both parties. Risk of loss passes to the Buyer upon delivery of the Vehicle.

Clause 5 – Payment

The Buyer shall pay the Purchase Price in full by the agreed payment method on or before the date of delivery. Accepted payment methods include bank transfer, cheque, or other mutually agreed forms.

Clause 6 – Registration and Transfer

The Buyer is responsible for registering the Vehicle in their name and for all associated costs and obligations. The Seller agrees to provide all necessary documents to facilitate transfer of ownership.

Clause 7 – Warranties and Representations

The Seller represents that to the best of their knowledge, the Vehicle's odometer reading is accurate and that the Vehicle has not been involved in any undisclosed accidents. No other warranties are made.

Clause 8 – Default

If either party breaches this Agreement and fails to remedy the breach within a reasonable time after notice, the non-breaching party may terminate this Agreement and seek any remedies available at law or in equity.

Clause 9 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding the sale of the Vehicle and supersedes all prior negotiations and understandings.

Clause 10 – Amendments

Any amendments or variations to this Agreement must be made in writing and signed by both parties.

Clause 11 – Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of New Zealand.

Clause 12 – Dispute Resolution

In the event of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, the parties agree to attempt resolution by negotiation or mediation before commencing legal proceedings.

Clause 13 – Notices

Any notice required to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered by hand, post, or email to the addresses specified in this Agreement.

Clause 14 – Privacy

The parties consent to the collection and use of their personal information for the purposes of this transaction and in compliance with applicable privacy laws.

Clause 15 – Signatures

This Agreement may be signed in counterparts and delivered by electronic means, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together constitute one agreement.
